Elk Mound "Village Park" Policy

- 1. Accept by prior approval from the Village Board, overnight camping is not permitted the Village Park. (Approved June 18, 2012 see attached Minutes)
- 2. There are no dogs allowed in the village parks to include Mound Hill and Lower Mound Hill Parks per Sections 7-6-6 and 7-1-7 of the Village Ordinances. (Approved June 18, 2012 see attached Minutes)
- 3. Picnic tables stamped "Village of Elk Mound" are not to be removed from the park (5) Red.
- 4. Picnic tables donated through the **Lions Club** may be checked out through a Lions Club member or the Clerk/Treasurer. The Clerk/Treasurer will maintain a record listing who has the tables, the number of tables checked out, and the length of time they will be checked out **(10) Green**.
- 5. The opening and the closing of the park is fixed by Village of Elk Mound Ordinance.
- 6. There is a minimum fee of (\$25.00) twenty five dollars for non-tournament use of a ball field and/or lights, for the first three hours of the event and (\$10.00) ten dollars per hour after the first three hours.
- 7. There is a reservation fee of use of a ball field during daylight hours of (\$10.00) ten dollars.
- 8. The Village of Elk Mound assumes responsibility for all care and maintenance of the park.
- 9. Reservations of the pavilion are to be made with the Village Clerk/Treasurer, and must be paid at the time the reservation is made.
- 10. A reservation fee for use of the pavilion of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per day for Village residents, Village property owners, and all raising events. A reservation fee of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) per day for non-residents. Elk Mound Lions members of good standing will pay a fee of \$25.00 per day.
- 11. It is the policy of the Elk Mound Village Board to allow league practice/games at regularly scheduled times when the pavilion is rented to the public.
- 12. There is a fee of (\$500.00) per year for baseball and softball league use of ball fields and lights. The fee is to be waived for Elk Mound Area Athletics in recognition of their contribution to the maintenance of our ball fields.
- 13. Groups of 500 or more are required to file with the Clerk/Treasurer a Certificate of Insurance in the amount of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) and to have the Village named as additional insured.
- 14. Tournaments:

Garbage Fee: \$100.00 per Weekend Fields and Lights: \$100.00 per Weekend Pavilion Rental: \$150.00 per Day

1 Day Tournament: \$350.002 Day Tournament: \$500.003 Day Tournament: \$650.00

Elk Mound Pitch Ball Tournament is considered a part of the Elk Mound Youth Athletics Summer League and we do not charge an additional fee for this event.

This park policy is the result of a cooperative effort on the park of the Elk Mound Lions Club and the Village Board of Elk Mound. This Park Policy is not to be altered in any way except for approval by the Village Board of Trustees for the Village of Elk Mound.
